Explorers And Adventurers

In the last week of the month, the class of Explorers and Adventurers revised all the types of vehicles and modes of transport covered during the month. Through rhymes, flashcards and interesting activities, the month flew by as the children learnt the importance of transport in their daily lives.

The children enjoyed the artwork this week as they learned more about transportation. The older children of the class of Adventurers had worksheets in addition.

Special Thursday was Sports this week and the children enjoyed themselves as they drove around their imaginary cars round and round in circles. As they held on to steering wheels it was nice to see them whizzing past their friends.

In the area of Montessori, the children are sorting objects according to Shape, Size and Colour.

Next week we will be starting of the new month of December with the UOI of Festivals.

Discoverers

Discoverers continued with the UOI on transport. Details on the different modes

Of transport were revised with the children.

Children were taught the difference between a ship and a boat. They were also introduced to names of different vehicle drivers. Wonderful songs associated with the UOI for the month was taught in class. It was a pleasure to see and hear the children sing those rhymes and tunes with their friends in class. With the help of such songs, the children are also taught about the importance of road safety for everyone.

Artwork this week had the children finger printing colouring of a huge ship.

In the area of Montessori, the children are



working on different materials and are now having fun transferring rice with a spoon, balancing on a beam and walking in a straight line. Special Thursday this week was an exciting cycle race wholly enjoyed by all the little ones.

With the Annual Day just around the corner, the children are all excited and busy practicing for it. Next week with the beginning of a new month we also begin a new UOI on festivals.

Enquirers

The enquirers started the week activity by making a model of a steering wheel. We also made colourful parachutes and endearing little engines with a bogey tagging along. The songs we learnt in the last two weeks were sung by the children with their models made in art class. We also learnt a couple of new songs 'C.A.R, V.A.N, B.U.S' that introduced them to new spellings.

Our worksheets reiterated traffic rules and some science concepts. The children used their innocent and practical experiences to figure out which object would float or sink in water.

On Special Thursday, our play area was converted into a busy street with traffic light and traffic signals. Children took the cycles and pretended that they were riding cars, trucks, scooters or vans and following traffic rules and traffic signs. The children enacted their roles very responsibly in relation to the traffic lights and some traffic rules.

In Montessori, the children were taught spindles and 0-9 counting with tokens and

cards.

Next week the Unit of Inquiry is Festivals.

Rangers

Our children enjoyed navigating their way through different traffic signs in the traffic zone set up at school and they were also treated to interesting audio visual programmes on road safety which contributed to them relating better to this week's UOI on road safety.

This week the Rangers learnt about ways and safety measures we have to follow in our day to day life to be safe and secure. Apart from this we also revised our previous concepts about different means and modes of transport and also discussed the uses and facilities available at railway stations and airports. The children were encouraged to solve worksheets on road safety, matching vehicles to words and grouping different means of transport according to the mode they belonged.

Art work comprised of colouring. On special Thursday sports children had lots of fun playing the traffic light game.

In the area of Geography we revised different continents of the world and different land forms. In Science children were introduced to the concept of 'Tools' and solved a worksheet on it. In Montessori the children were introduced to Pictures and Labels Box 4, Secret Box 5 and the Subtraction Strip Board.

On Friday we closed our unit of inquiry for the month of November. Going forward next month we will be inquiring into a very interesting topic-'Festivals'.
